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POLICY ON USE OF ALCOLHOL & DRUGS

It is the policy of the Silver Lake Ski Club to follow all laws of the State of Michigan regarding the use of drugs & alcohol. It is the expectation of the Board that every member abides by those laws, and if legal to consume alcohol, does so responsibly and with common sense. This is particularly critical before competitions and shows. Anyone thought to be intoxicated or impaired at the time of a practice or performance will not be allowed to participate in that event, subject to disciplinary action by the SLSC Board.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way with the Silver Lake Ski Club and all related events, the undersigned:

- 1. Agrees that prior to participation, they each will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if they believe anything is unsafe, they will immediately advise a supervisor or Board member of such conditions(s) and refuse to participate.
- 2. Agrees that as parent(s) or legal guardian(s) he/she will instruct the minor participants that prior to participating they each will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if they believe anything is unsafe, they will immediately advise their coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
- 3. Acknowledges and fully understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death. Severe social and economic losses might result not only from their own actions, inactions, or negligence, but the actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, there may be other risks not known to us, or not reasonably foreseeable at the time.
- 4. Assumes all the foregoing risks and accepts personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
- 5. Releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue the Silver Lake Ski Club, its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertiser, the City of Fenton, all officials of the City of Fenton, and their representatives, successors, and if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "release" from any and all liability to each of the undersigned, his or her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses of damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the release otherwise.

FUNDRAISING POLICY & SPONSORSHIP

Fundraising is an integral part of the SLSC experience and each member is expected to participate in fundraising activities. Information on specific fundraisers will be provided throughout the year. Sponsorship is also critical, and all members are encouraged to help gain and/or actively support SLSC sponsors.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

The Silver Lake Ski Club maintains safety regulations for the safety of its members. All team members are required to abide by these regulations for their participation.

- 1. Under no circumstances will a member be allowed to participate in practices, shows, or tournaments without proof of current USA Waterski membership.
- 2. Skiers may not wear jewelry of any kind (including but not limited to: rings, earrings, naval rings) while participating in practices, shows, or tournaments. If it is not possible to remove a piece of jewelry, it must be taped at all times.
- 3. Gum chewing is not permitted at any time during the course of a practice, show, and/or tournament.
- 4. When a skier falls and is uninjured, he or she must wave to signal that they are okay, make eye contact with the nearest driver, and then gather all equipment nearby.
- 5. No horseplay will be permitted on the shoreline or docks at any time.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the skier(s) to ensure that proper equipment is used (vests, helmets, etc.) at all times.
- 7. In the event of an injury, only the safety committee will have access to the first aid equipment and attend to the injured person. The Safety Director must be informed of all ski club related injuries.
